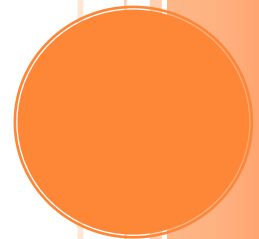

Our mission is transforming the lives of teenage mothers in Cameroon and educating teenagers to fight teenage pregnancy among them thereby ensuring a better future for the Cameroonian youth.

Our objectives are;

- To prevent teenage pregnancies and STD's through sexual and reproductive health education.
- To identify teenage mothers in the community and enroll them into vocational training program/entrepreneurship.
- Establishment of teenage mothers through micro-loans with small interest, then follow-up.

Activities

After BleekerFoundation was fully recognized and approved in October 2015, the board members worked hard in putting in ideas for the website. We succeeded in creating a working website before the end of 2015.

19th of October 2015, BleekerFoundation gave a fundraising presentation to the Soroptimist International women empowerment group in Hoorn, the Netherlands.

26th of November 2015, BleekerFoundation took part in the Westfries stock exchange program. Where big companies and small companies/NGO's came together to share initiative and help each other to achieve their goals.
